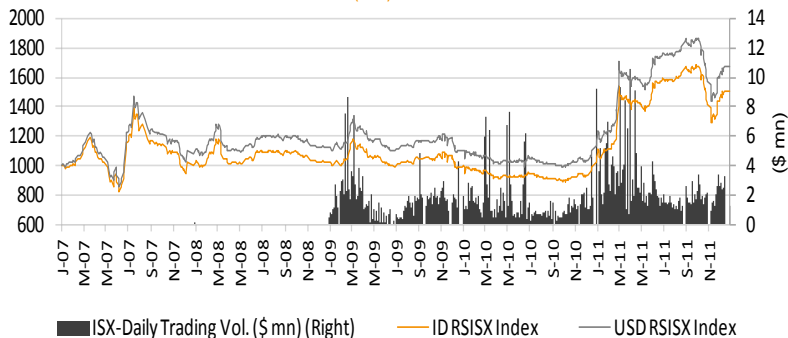

**News from Iraq**

**Politics**

- The EU urged the Iraqi government and its political parties to solve their political differences through dialogue, according to the electronic site of the Foreign Ministry. (Aswat Al-Iraq)
- Premier Nouri al-Maliki on Tuesday received US Congressman Senator Josef Lieberman, a statement announced. The statement said that Premier Maliki stressed the necessity of developing bilateral relations based on joint interests and respect. (Zawya)
- The Iraqi House of Representatives convened to discuss a number of bills yesterday (Jan.3) after a period of suspension while the Iraqiya List deputies did not attend the session. Yesterday was the end of a 15-day deadline announced for Iraqiya deputies (91 in the 325-member House) to end their boycott. Iraqiya List lawmakers and ministers have boycotted sessions in protest to what they have described "lack of real partnership in political process and unilateral ruling in the country." Iraqiya's boycott was announced when the PM Nouri al-Maliki opposed strongly to demands of regional autonomy by Diyala and Salahaddin provincial councils, dominated by Iraqiya deputies. (Aknews)

**Economics**

- Iraqi oil marketing company (SOMO) declared on Monday that the export earnings amounted to about \$83bn for the whole year. (Iraq Directory)
- Najaf Refinery hit a 30% rise in overall production in 2011 as compared to a year earlier that could increase the petrodollar income of the Najaf province, Director of the Najaf refinery said on Tuesday. (AKnews)
- Iraq's Central Bank says it will not allow the Iraqi dinar to depreciate and has been selling hundreds of millions of dollars to keep the currency stable, according to a report from Azzaman. (Iraq Business News)
