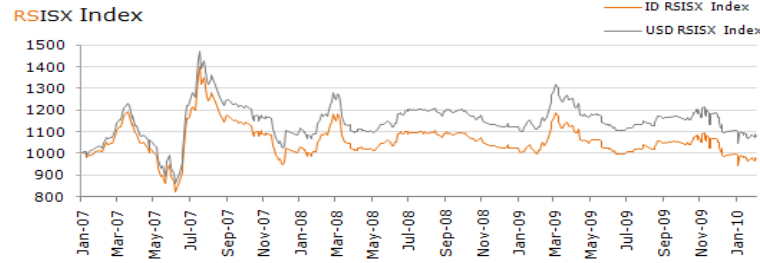

### News From Iraq

#### Politics

- Head of the Supreme Iraqi Islamic Council, Ammar al-Hakim said on Tuesday that Iraq believes in setting up international and opened relations globally, while the French ambassador in Baghdad vowed that his country will support Iraq in all fields, according to a SIIC statement.
- The head of the Supreme Iraqi Islamic Council, Ammar al-Hakim, on Tuesday called on the Czech Republic to urge European Union countries to boost relations with Iraq, according to a statement released by the SIIC.
- US Ambassador to Iraq Christopher Hill affirmed that the US Government is deploying utmost efforts to support displaced and help improve their economic status. He said the decision by Justice and Accountability Commission to ban Baathists from Iraq politics and cancel their candidature in elections is an internal affair and no one should intervene within.
- At least 10 polling stations are to open in Jordan for Iraqi expatriates to take part in their country's March 7 election, as part of worldwide out-of-country voting, Iraq's ambassador said on Tuesday.

#### Economics

- Minister of Planning, Ali Baban, said that his ministry was able to complete a five-year development plan for the years 2010-2014, indicating that it a comprehensive plan in its economic, social, humanitarian and public services and the infrastructure.
- Iraqi Oil Minister, Hussain al-Shahristani, told reporters on Tuesday that Iraq expects to resume oil exports from the province of Kurdistan in the near future.
- Iraqi Trade Ministry said on Tuesday that Iraq needs the U.S. as an investor and strategic partner to form a developed economy.
- An agreement was signed on Tuesday by al-Muthanna provincial authority and a Swiss firm to build 3,000 furnished residential units for poor families in the province.
- Iraqi Agriculture Ministry examined on Tuesday a number of research papers to develop rice production in Iraq in 2010.

**Daily Transactions in Brief**

The Iraq Stock Exchange held the eighth session of the month today. 33 companies were able to trade in this session, and 48 companies were unable to do so mainly due to their General Assembly Meeting. The number of traded shares was 428.5 mn and the trading volume was ID889.7 mn (US\$760.4 ths).

Foreigners executed 19 transactions in this session. They executed 15 buying transactions in two companies operating in banking sector, and four selling transactions in three companies operating in banking, services and industry sectors. The total number of traded shares was 19.7 mn, and the total trading volume was ID101.4 mn (US\$86.7 ths). According to trading volumes, the companies which were bought by foreigners are Dar Es Salaam Investment Bank (BDSI) and Bank of Baghdad (BBOB), while the companies which were sold by foreigners are Iraqi Middle East Investment Bank (BIME), Mamoura Realestate (SMRI) and National Chemical Industries (INCP).
